♥ Valentine Bay Window Card ♥



Supplies:

- Stamp set Sweet Conversations (157618); Sweet Hearts Dies (157623);
 Bouquet of Love Dies (157641) for a label
- Cardstocks Thick Basic White (159229); Highland Heather (146986); Petal Pink (146985)
- Designer series paper 12"x12" Sweet Talk (157616)
- Inkpads Real Red (147084); Highland Heather (147103); Petal Pink (147108)
- Misc. Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430);
 Tear & Tape Adhesive (154031); Multipurpose Liquid Glue(110755); Standard
 Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Bone Folder (102300).

Measurements:

- Basic White card base $4\frac{1}{4}$ "x 11", scoring along the long side at 3/8", 17/8", 35/8", 51/8" & $5\frac{1}{2}$ ", & use scrap for a sentiment.
- Red Glitter paper 3"x 3" for the label and hearts
- DSP: (2) $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (purple strips), (2) 1 3/8" x 4 1/8" (mini hearts); (2) 1 5/8" x 4 1/8" (purple panels)
- Purple cardstock (1) 3" x 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " for two mini envelopes for inside card
- Petal pink cardstock (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for a sentiment

Instructions:

• Begin with a 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 11 card base of Basic White cardstock. Score along the long side at 3/8", 1 7/8", 3 5/8", 5 1/8", and 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Burnish your folds w/Bone Folder and start to create the bay window shape.

- After folding the card in half, you have the small inside fold. Put a strip of Tear and Tape adhesive in the smallest section between the score lines.
- Front: Adhere the (2) pieces of contrasting DSP that measure 4 $1/8 \times \frac{1}{4}$ to the small sections at both sides of your bay window.
- Next, attach the 2 DSP panels to the left and right panels. Finally, attach a
 purple panel to the center panel.
- Crop a label from the red glitter paper with the coordinating Bouquet of Love Dies.
- Stamp the sentiment 'Happy Valentine's Day' in Real Red classic ink onto a scrap of Basic White cardstock. Fussy cut the sentiment. Adhere with Stampin' Dimensionals to the red glitter label and the center panel with the liquid glue.



Inside of the card

- Crop two little envelopes from the Highland Heather cardstock with the coordinating Sweet Talks Dies.
- Fold the 2-sided flaps and add small dot amount of liquid glue to hold the 2 sides. Then you fold bottom flap in and add along the rounded edge flap with liquid glue with just a little bit.
 - Adhere the envelopes onto the inside of the card as shown.
- Stamp the sentiments (Sweet Conversations) in Highland Heather Classic ink onto the Petal Pink cardstock and crop the square and heart with the coordinating Sweet Talks Dies. Adhere with the liquid glue to the card.
- Adhere the purple DSP with the liquid glue to the far right. Attach the red heart onto the purple panel with the dimensionals and the gems on the top as shown.
