



## StampTwist technique how-to: Adding motion $\stackrel{\circ}{=}$

Add motion to stamped images with a tiny twist. Ink stamp. Press stamp straight down onto paper. Freeze. Gently lift top edge only of stamp, bottom edge continues touching the paper. Make a tiny twist (1/8) to the right, top edge of stamp only. Press whole stamp down again. Lift stamp to reveal first— and second—generation stamping adding motion to your designs. This technique is meant as quick stamping and is not intended to be precise.



Stamp · Freeze · Twist · Stamp

For this card:

Stamp solid leaf image (oval-shaped) 2x with Cajun Craze ink-

Upper-left corner. Press stamp onto paper. Freeze. Lifting top only, gently twist slightly to the right. Press down again.

Repeat with same stamp in bottom-right corner. Image will likely fall of the page and not be shown completely.

Stamp <u>outline leaf image (oval-shaped)</u> over both top and bottom images. No need to line up images perfectly.

Stamp solid leaf image (lobed) 1x with Pumpkin Pie ink-

Between the previous images, press stamp onto paper. Freeze. Lifting top only, gently twist slightly to the right. Press down again.

Stamp outline leaf image (lobed) over image. No need to line up images perfectly.

Ink <u>sentiment</u> with Wild Wheat-Stamp on strip and trim to size

Assemble as shown in photograph and sample
