Supplies

- Card base: card stock (1) 4-1/2" x 11"
- Mechanisms (1) and (2): card stock (2) 3" x 10"
- Inside panels: card stock or papers (2) 4" square
- Mini-panels: papers (4) 2-1/4" x 2-3/4"
- Embellishment bits and parts as desired.
- Card front as desired.

## Scoring

- 1. Card base: score in half lengthwise and fold to form a 4-1/4'' by 5-1/2'' card.
- 2. Mechanism (1) the POPTWIST:

A. With the 10" edge across the top, score at 3-1/2" and 6-1/2."


B. Turn one turn (3" edge across the top). Score an X through the center box. Use the 3-1/2" and 6-1/2" score marks as a guide.

C. From the 3" to 3" edge, score in half (1-1/2") This score line should pass directly through the center **X**.

D. Fold all score lines. Push the 3" to 3" score line into itself to form a simple house shape.

3. Mechanism (2) the cover panel:

A. With the 10" edge across the top, score at [2-1/2"] [5"] [7-1/2"]



## Assembly

1. Attach the 4" square inside panels to the card, one centered at the top, the other at the bottom.

2. Add mechanism (1); it should be in folded form (simple house shape). Apply adhesive to one triangle. Center inside the card so the point of the "roof" is next to, but not touching, the center card base fold line. Close the card over the mechanism. Open card and apply adhesive to the opposite triangle and fold closed again. SLIGHTLY trim (to the center score line) the upper-left and lower-right boxes of the mechanism.

3. Add mechanism (2) the cover panel. Apply a small amount of adhesive to the lower-left and upper-right uncut corners of mechanism (1). Attach the cover panel, lining up uncut corners precisely. Close and open the card a few times to ensure it is working properly.

4. Add the mini panels to the cover panel.

5. Embellish.
