**MAGIC WALLET CARDS**  
*with Lisa Salkeld*

◆Supplies

- (4) same-size card stock panels; you need 2 front panels and 2 back panels; add design papers as desired before assembling card
  - (4) lengths of ribbon approximately two inches wider than panel/card width
  - Tape or tape-runner for securing ribbons, glue for adhering panels
- Special note: When securing ribbon, fit should be cozy, not too tight, not too loose.

◆Creating your card base

Parallel ribbons

\_\_\_Place two panels side by side and right side up. These are the inside front and inside back panels (Remaining two unused panels are saved for last, as front and back covers for the card)

\_\_\_Working on the left panel, place two parallel ribbon lengths, one toward the top, the other toward the bottom. Leave approximately two inches of space between them, or approximately 'gift-card' distanced. Use de-tacked tape placed front and center to temporarily hold the ribbons in place

\_\_\_Flip the left panel over, wrong side facing up-left panel only, do nothing with right panel

\_\_\_Working on the left panel, right edge only, fold over the ribbon and adhere permanently to the panel

\_\_\_Flip over left panel, right side facing up with raw ribbon ends to the right. Make a sandwich by placing the right panel face down on the left, making sure right sides are together

\_\_\_Working on right edge only, fold over the ribbon and adhere permanently to the panel

\_\_\_Open card to the right and remove de-tacked tape

\_\_\_Open panels completely out. Left panel is wrong side up, right panel is right side up, ribbons are stretched between the panels. Parallel ribbons are complete

### Crisscross ribbons

\_\_\_ Working on the right panel only, place two ribbons crisscross through the middle of the panel. Crisscross ribbons must stay between parallel ribbons, or where the parallel ribbon lengths would sit on the panel. Use de-tacked tape placed front and center to temporarily hold the ribbon in place

\_\_\_ Tricky → Make a sandwich by picking left panel straight up, sliding over, and placing face down on right panel, making sure right sides are together

\_\_\_ Working on left edge only, fold over the ribbon and adhere permanently to the panel

\_\_\_ Flip sandwich over, raw ribbon ends to the left. Working on left edge only, fold over the ribbon and adhere permanently to the panel

\_\_\_ Open card to the left and remove de-tacked tape. Inside panels are complete

### Cover panels

\_\_\_ Close inside panels and add remaining (2) card stock panels, one front cover and one back cover, to complete card. Embellish as desired
