

Card Techniques:

Scrappy Strips #9

Deckled Circles & Scrappy Strips

All Products I used are from Stampin Up!



Complete Card Supplies:

Thick Basic White Cardstock (cut 4 1/4" x 11") Scored at 5 1/2" and folded for card base

Basic White Cardstock (cut 3" x 5") to use with the Scrappy Strips

Sunny Days 12" x 12" DSP (Cut 1/2" x 6") Cut at least 10 strips of various prints of Strips

SCRAPS of Basic White & Basic Black Cardstocks...for die cutting words

Stampin' Dies: Wanted to Say & Deckled Circles

Black & White Gingham Ribbon

Classic Matte Dots

Dimensionals

Adhesive of your Choice

Directions:

1. Using the 3" x 5" pc of Basic White cs, adhere the 1/2" DSP pcs lining them right next to each other. Fill the whole pc of cs.
2. Cut off excess strips from the pc of cs and save for another project.
3. Using the 4" deckled circle die, counting from the largest in, lay onto your Scrappy Piece of cs and cut at least half of the circle.
4. Adhere the half circle pc to your card base using dimensionals.
5. With the Wanted to Say dies, cut a set of sentiments to use on the front of your card. I cut the words in Basic Black and the background in the Basic White. Adhere to card front with dimensionals. You only need to put dimensionals on the back right side and glue on the back left side to adhere. That way it sits even on the deckled circle.
6. Tie a bow with the ribbon and add to the front of the card.
7. Add the Matte Dots to the front of the card to embellish.
8. Add a strip of DSP to the inside of the card.
