## Card Techniques:

## Hooray for Surprises Directions are for the Birthday Card with the Cakes All Products I used are from Stampin Up!



Complete Card Supplies:

Blackberry Bliss Cardstock (cut 4 1/4" x 11") scored at 5 1/2" for card base Basic White Cardstock (cut 5 1/4" x 4") for inside of card Basic White Cardstock (cut 3" x 4 1/2") for front of card (Use with Stripes & Splatters Embossing Folder) Basic White Cardstock (cut 1 ¼" x 5") for front of card (use with Hooray for Surprises Die Cuts) Fresh Freesia Cardstock (cut 1 ¼" x 5") for front of card (use with Hooray for Surprises Die Cuts) Delightful Floral 12" x 12" DSP (cut 5 ¼" x 4") for front of card SCRAP of Basic White Cardstock for Birthday cakes and die cutting them Scraps of Blackberry Bliss, Parakeet Party, Calypso Coral and Fresh Freesia (for die cutting flowers) Stamp Set: Hooray for Surprises Stampin' Ink: Blackberry Bliss, Parakeet Party, Calypso Coral, Fresh Freesia Memento Tuxedo Black Ink **Dies: Hooray for Surprises Ink** Stripes & Splatters Embossing Folders Iridescent Pearls Basic Gems Stamp N Cut Emboss Machine Dimensionals Adhesive of your Choice

## Directions:

- 1. Take your pc of DSP and adhere it to your Blackberry Bliss card base.
- 2. On your 3' x 4 ½" pc of Basic White cs, measure down from the top to approx. 1- 1 1/8 inches. From the bottom measure up to about ¾-1 inches. Run your pc through the embossing folder only embossing the top down to your measured line and then do the same on the bottom, only embossing to the measured line. This will give you a place for your sentiment. Adhere this pc to your card base.
- 3. Take the pc of Fresh Freesia cs and the Basic White that measures the same. Lay the Basic White on top of the Fresh Freesia, then lay the strip die cut centered on top of them and emboss at the same time. Peel back the perforated part of the Basic White one and leave the Fresh Freesia one in tack.
- 4. Adhere the Basic White pc, that has the perforation part removed, to the smooth part of the Basic White pc that is adhered to the card base. Stamp your sentiment onto the Basic White pc between the perforated pc.
- 5. Adhere the Fresh Freesia pc directly on top of the Basic White pc. Stamp the word "pull" onto the Fresh Freesia pc.
- 6. Stamp FIVE of the birthday cakes in the different colors. One will be for the inside of the card. Die cut them with the birthday cake die.
- 7. Cut out the small flowers from the die set with the different colors of DSP. You will cut one of each of the cakes on the front of the card and 5 extra Fresh Freesia flowers for the Freesh Freesia pc that is perforated.
- 8. Add the flowers to the cakes and to the Fresh Freesia pc.

- 9. Add the cakes to the front of the card with dimensionals.
- 10. Add the 5<sup>th</sup> birthday cake to the pc of Basic White cs for the inside of the card. You can also add the Birthday sentiment to the inside.
- 11. Embellish the flowers with the Iridescent flowers.
