

# Rustic Poinsettia Christmas Card

Base	Early Espresso	4 1/4" x 11"	Score at 5 1/2" to create a top-folding card
Back Decorative Panel	Brushed Metallic Foil Paper in Copper	2 3/4" x 5"	
Middle Decorative Panel	Red Berry Sprigs DSP	3" x 4 1/2"	
Front Decorative Panel	Wood Grain DSP	2 1/2" x 3 1/2"	
Larger Layer	Early Espresso	3 1/8" x 4 5/8"	
Smaller Layer	Early Espresso	2 5/8" x 3 5/8"	
Sentiment Strip	Very Vanilla	1" x 3"	
Sentiment Layer	Early Espresso	1 1/8" x 3 1/8"	
Decorative Flower	Cherry Cobbler	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Sprigs	Brushed Metallic Foil Paper in Copper	1 1/2" x 4"	
Card Interior	Very Vanilla	4 1/8" x 5 3/8"	

- 1) Score and fold card base at 5 1/2" to make a top-folding card.
- 2) Using brushed metallic copper paper, cut out 2 sprigs from the middle of the left edge of the paper using the sprig from the Poinsettia Dies die set
- 3) Adhere brushed metallic panel to front of card base leaving 3/8" margin at the top, right, and bottom
- 4) Adhere the back decorative panel to the Early Espresso layer. Adhere to card base centered top/bottom to the metallic, and 1/2" from the left edge.
- 5) Adhere the wood grain paper to the smaller Early Espresso layer. Adhere to the card base 1/2" from the right edge, 1 1/8" from the top edge.
- 6) Stamp the outer sentiment a little offset to the left using the Season's Greetings stamp from the Peaceful Boughs stamp set onto the Very Vanilla strip.
- 7) Adhere the sentiment strip to the Early Espresso layer, leaving 1/16" of a border all around.
- 8) Adhere three red Wonderful Gems to the right edge of the sentiment strip.
- 9) Cut the 4 layers of flower petals out of Cherry Cobbler paper using the Poinsettia Dies.
- 10) Adhere each layer of petals together using a glue dot at the center between layers.
- 11) Lay out the positioning of the sprigs and poinsettia on the card front. Adhere sprigs down with glue, poinsettia with glue or a glue dot.
- 12) Adhere three small Wonderful Gems to the right edge of the sentiment strip.
- 13) Stamp a sentiment on inside of card on Very Vanilla paper and adhere to card interior.
- 14) Sit back and admire your handiwork! That's one nice looking card!
