

Festive Snowflake Christmas Shaker Card

Base	Pacific Point	4 1/4" x 11"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Back Layer	Tiny Blue Snowflakes DSP	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Top Layer	Whisper White	4" x 5 1/2"

Large Snowflakes DSP

- 1) Score and fold card base at 5 1/2" to make a top-folding portrait card base.
- 2) Using the label die from the So Many Snowflakes dies, cut the shaker window out of the Whisper White top layer, top edge of the die 3/8" from the top.
- 3) Set the top layer on top of the Pacific Point card base, centered in the middle of the card.
- 4) Position the Tiny Snowflakes paper so it sits behind the shaker window opening. Lightly pencil some marks to note where the shaker window opening sits.
- 5) Adhere the Tiny Snowflakes paper in place.
- 6) Stamp the sentiment from the Poinsettia Petals stamp set onto the top layer using Pacific Point ink, along the bottom.
- 7) Adhere a piece of window sheet to the back side of the top layer.
- 8) Take Foam Adhesive strips and place them along the pencil marks in the shape of the shaker window opening, just outside the edges of the window.
- 9) Place a generous amount of Snowflake Sequins and Whale of a Time sequins (removing the pink seashells, keeping just blue-toned sequins).
- 10) Add some Foam Adhesive Strips to the outer edges of the card to support the Whisper White top layer.
- 11) Remove the top protective covering on the foam adhesive strips. Place the Whisper White layer on the strips, centered left/right.
- 12) Adhere the snowflakes around the edges of the window opening, slightly overlapping into the opening.
- 13) Place Blue Gems in the centers of the snowflakes.
