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Wintry Poinsettia Christmas Card 1

	<u>Paper</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Treatment</u>
Base	Basic Gray	4 1/4" x 11"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Back Layer	Feels Like Frost Twigs	4" x 5 1/4"	
Embossed Strip	Basic Gray	1 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Sentiment Strip	Whisper White	3/4" x 3"	
Poinsettia Base	Whisper White	3" x 3"	
Decorative Elements	Silver Foil	4" x 6"	

- 1) Score card base at 5 1/2" and fold in half to make a tent-fold card base
- 2) Adhere Twigs DSP, leaving a 1/8" reveal all around
- 3) Using the Poinsettia dies, cut a flocked vellum flower from the PLUSH POINSETTIA SPECIALTY PAPER
- 4) Using the Poinsettia dies, cut a flower from the scrap of Whisper White
- 5) Adhere the vellum poinsettia to the Whisper White poinsettia
- 6) Using the Poinsettia dies, cut a flower center and a sprig from the Silver Foil paper
- 7) Stamp Merry Christmas with Versamark ink onto the sentiment strip using the stamp from the Cherish The Season Stamp set (see note below)
- 8) Sprinkle silver embossing powder onto the Versamark, heat to melt
- 9) Using the Lovely Labels Pick a Punch curvy side, punch out both ends of the sentiment strip.
- 10) Using Versamark Ink, randomly stamp poinsettias on the grey strip using the smaller, full flower from the Poinsettia Petals stamp set
- 11) Sprinkle silver embossing powder onto the Versamark, heat to melt
- 12) Adhere the grey strip to the Twigs DSP, 1/2" from the edge of the DSP
- 13) Glue the silver sprig to the Twigs DSP, then adhere the layered poinsettia to the grey strip using Stampin Dimensionals
- 14) Adhere the sentiment with Stampin Dimensionals
- 15) Decorate with 3 frosted Epoxy dots
- 16) Sit back and admire your handiwork!
- 17) NOTE: The Merry Christmas sentiment from the Poinsettia Petals stamp set is too large for a portrait-oriented card



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Wintry Poinsettia Christmas Card 2

	<u>Paper</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Treatment</u>
Base	Whisper White	4 1/4" x 11"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Back Layer	Grey Granite	1 1/8" x 5 3/8"	
Embossed Strip	Remainder of Twigs DSP	2" x 5 1/2"	
Sentiment Strip	Whisper White	3/4" x 3"	
Poinsettia Base	Whisper White	3" x 3"	
Decorative Elements	Silver Foil	4" x 6"	
Sentiment Base	Grey Granite	1" x 3 1/4"	

- 1) Score card base at 5 1/2" and fold in half to make a tent-fold card base
- 2) Spray the Grey Granite panel with a fine mist of CHAMPAGNE MIST SHIMMER PAINT in water
- 3) Once mostly dry, run the Grey Granite panel through your die cutting machine in the Dainty Diamonds embossing folder
- 4) Adhere the Grey Granite paper to the card base
- 5) Adhere the Twigs DSP strip to the embossed Grey Granite paper, 1/2" from the left edge
- 6) Using the Poinsettia dies, cut a flocked vellum flower from the PLUSH POINSETTIA SPECIALTY PAPER
- 7) Using the Poinsettia dies, cut a flower from the scrap of Whisper White
- 8) Adhere the vellum poinsettia to the Whisper White poinsettia
- 9) Using the Poinsettia dies, cut a flower center and a sprig from the Silver Foil paper
- 10) Stamp Merry Christmas with Versamark ink onto the sentiment strip using the stamp from the Cherish The Season Stamp set (see note below)
- 11) Sprinkle silver embossing powder onto the Versamark, heat to melt
- 12) Using the Lovely Labels Pick a Punch curvy side, punch out both ends of the sentiment strip as well as the Grey Granite sentiment backer.
- 13) Glue the silver sprig to the embossed Grey Granite panel, then adhere the layered poinsettia to the grey strip using Stampin Dimensionals
- 14) Adhere the sentiment to the Grey Granite backer, then attach the combined piece to the card front with Stampin Dimensionals
- 15) Decorate with 3 clear Epoxy dots
- 16) Sit back and admire your handiwork!
- 17) NOTE: The Merry Christmas sentiment from the Poinsettia Petals stamp set is too large for a portrait-oriented card



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Wintry Poinsettia Christmas Card 3

	<u>Paper</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Treatment</u>
Base	Basic Grey	4 1/4" x 11"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Back Layer	Pink/blackberry leaves DSP	4" x 5 1/2"	
Poinsettia Petals	Thick Whisper White	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Sentiment	Whisper White	2 1/2" x 3"	
Decorative Elements	Blackberry Bliss	2" x 5 1/2"	

- 1) Score card base at 5 1/2" and fold in half to make a tent-fold card base
- 2) Adhere the Leaf DSP to the card base, leaving 1/8" reveal left and right
- 3) Cut the 3 largest Poinsettia petals from Whisper White cardstock in your die cutting machine, with the leaf vein pieces centered in the petals
- 4) Adhere the 3 layers of petals to each other, offsetting each layer's petals from the next
- 5) Cut a sprig, flower center and the medium Joy sentiment (from the Peace and Joy die set) from Blackberry Bliss paper
- 6) Adhere the sprig to the card front using glue
- 7) Adhere the flower center to the center of the poinsettia flower. Attach to card front using your choice of adhesives
- 8) Cut the smallest Joy from Whisper White cardstock, glue to the Blackberry Bliss medium die cut
- 9) Stamp the "TO YOU AND YOURS" sentiment from the Peace and Joy bundle onto a 1/2" strip of Whisper White cardstock using Blackberry Bliss ink
- 10) Cut the sentiment out flush to the edge of the Blackberry Bliss
- 11) Adhere the Joy to the bottom of the card front, and the TO YOU AND YOURS right below it using glue
- 12) Sit back and admire your handiwork!



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Wintry Poinsettia Christmas Card 4

	<u>Paper</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Treatment</u>
Base	Whisper White	4 1/4" x 11"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Back Layer	Grey Granite	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Leafy Strip Backer	Blackberry Bliss	1/2" x 5 1/2"	
Decorative Strip	Leafy DSP strip	1 1/2" x 5 1/2"	
Poinsettia Petals	Thick Whisper White	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Sentiment	Whisper White	2 1/2" x 3"	
Decorative Elements	Blackberry Bliss	2" x 5 1/2"	

- 1) Score card base at 5 1/2" and fold in half to make a tent-fold card base
- 2) Spray the Grey Granite panel with a fine mist of CHAMPAGNE MIST SHIMMER PAINT in water
- 3) Once mostly dry, run the Grey Granite panel through your die cutting machine in the Dainty Diamonds embossing folder
- 4) Adhere the Grey Granite paper to the card base
- 5) Adhere the Blackberry Bliss to the Leafy DSP strip, leaving a 1/8" reveal on each side
- 6) Attach the Leafy strip to the Grey Granite embossed card front, 1/2" from the left edge
- 7) Cut the 3 largest Poinsettia petals from Whisper White cardstock in your die cutting machine, with the leaf vein pieces centered in the petals
- 8) Adhere the 3 layers of petals to each other, offsetting each layer's petals from the next
- 9) Cut a sprig, flower center and the medium Peace sentiment (from the Peace and Joy die set) from Blackberry Bliss paper
- 10) Adhere the sprig to the card front using glue
- 11) Adhere the flower center to the center of the poinsettia flower. Attach to card front using your choice of adhesives
- 12) Cut the smallest Peace from Whisper White cardstock, glue to the Blackberry Bliss medium die cut
- 13) Glue the Peace sentiment to the bottom of the card front
- 14) Sit back and admire your handiwork!



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Wintry Poinsettia Christmas Card 5

	<u>Paper</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Treatment</u>
Base	Whisper White cardstock	5 1/2" x 8 1/4"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Back Layer	Seaside Spray cardstock	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Poinsettia Petals	Thick Whisper White	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Sentiment	Silver Foil	2" x 3"	
Decorative Elements	Whisper White cardstock	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	

- 1) Score card base at 4 3/4" and fold in half to make a tent-fold card base
- 2) Spray the Seaside Spray panel with a fine mist of CHAMPAGNE MIST SHIMMER PAINT in water
- 3) Once mostly dry, run the Seaside Spray panel through your die cutting machine in the Parisian Flourish embossing folder
- 4) Adhere the embossed Seaside Spray paper to the card base
- 5) Cut the 3 largest Poinsettia petals from Whisper White cardstock in your die cutting machine, with the leaf vein pieces centered in the petals
- 6) Adhere the 3 layers of petals to each other, offsetting each layer's petals from the next
- 7) Cut a sprig and 3 small Peace sentiments (from the Peace and Joy die set) from Whisper White
- 8) Cut a flower center and one small Peace sentiment from the Silver Foil paper
- 9) Adhere the sprig to the card front using glue
- 10) Adhere the flower center to the center of the poinsettia flower. Attach to card front using your choice of adhesives
- 11) Glue the 3 Whisper White Peace die cuts together, then top with the Silver die cut, set aside to dry
- 12) Once dried, glue the Peace sentiment to the bottom of the card front
- 13) Decorate with 3 frosted Epoxy dots
- 14) Sit back and admire your handiwork!



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Wintry Poinsettia Christmas Card 6

	<u>Paper</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Treatment</u>
Base	Whisper White	4 1/4" x 11"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Back Layer	Silver Foil, 2 strips, each	1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Front panel	Seaside Spray	4" x 5 1/2"	
Decorative Inset	Wintry Trees at Sunrise DSP	3 1/4" x 4 1/4"	
Sentiment Strip	Whisper White	3/4" x 3"	

- 1) Score card base at 5½" and fold in half to make a tent-fold card base
- 2) Adhere the Silver Foil strips to the left and right edges of the card base
- 3) First, cut a 1 3/4" tall, 6" wide strip from the bottom of the Wintry Trees DSP. Then, from the remainder, cut the top piece 3 1/4" wide to include the tall tree.
- 4) Using the 4th from the largest Stitched Rectangle die, cut a window in the Seaside Spray panel, centered left/right, 3/8" from the top
- 5) Glue the Wintry Tree panel, tree side facing out, to the back of the Seaside Spray frame.
- 6) Adhere the Seaside Spray frame/Wintry Trees panel to the card front, leaving 1/8" reveal left and right.
- 7) Stamp Merry Christmas with Versamark ink onto the sentiment strip using the stamp from the Cherish The Season Stamp set (see note below)
- 8) Sprinkle silver embossing powder onto the Versamark, heat to melt
- 9) Using the Lovely Labels Pick a Punch curvy side, punch out both ends of the sentiment strip.
- 10) Adhere the sentiment strip, centered left/right and with an even reveal top/bottom, to the bottom of the Seaside Spray panel
- 11) Sit back and admire your handiwork!



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Wintry Poinsettia Christmas Card 7

	<u>Paper</u>	<u>Dimensions</u>	<u>Treatment</u>
Base	Whisper White	5 1/2" x 8 1/4"	Score at 5 1/2", Fold in half to create a top-folding card
Top Layer	Blackberry Bliss	3 1/2" x 5 1/2"	
Poinsettia Petals	Blushing Bride cardstock	4 1/4" x 5 1/2"	
Bottom Layer	Bottom cut of Wintry Trees at Sunrise	1 3/4" x 5 1/2"	
Decorative Elements	Silver Foil	4" x 6"	

- 1) Score card base at 4 1/4" and fold in half to make a tent-fold card base
- 2) Using the Zigzag edge die from the Autumn Essentials dies, die cut the Blackberry Bliss panel along the long edge.
- 3) Trim to a total of 3 1/4" high by 5 1/2" wide
- 4) Run the Blackberry Bliss panel through your die cutting machine inside the cross-hatch Wrapped in Texture embossing folder
- 5) Cut the Wintry Trees panel to 1 1/4" x 5 1/2". Glue the 1/2" offcut to the inside bottom edge of the card base as a decorative element
- 6) Adhere the Wintry Trees 1 1/4" strip to the bottom of the card base
- 7) Adhere the embossed Blackberry Bliss panel on top of it, the bottom DSP should just be covered by the zigzag edge
- 8) Cut the 3 largest Poinsettia petals from Blushing Bride cardstock in your die cutting machine, with the leaf vein pieces centered in the petals
- 9) Adhere the 3 layers of petals to each other, offsetting each layer's petals from the next
- 10) Cut a sprig, flower center and the smallest Joy sentiment (from the Peace and Joy die set) from the Silver Foil paper
- 11) Adhere the sprig to the card front using glue
- 12) Adhere the flower center to the center of the poinsettia flower. Attach to card front using your choice of adhesives
- 13) Adhere the Joy to the right side of the Blackberry Bliss panel
- 14) Decorate the card with 3 pink Elegant Gems
- 15) Sit back and admire your handiwork!



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
