## **SUPPLIES USED**

### **TOOLS**

Wanted to Say dies  
Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

### **ACCESSORIES**

Paper Trimmer  
Brushed Brass Butterflies

### **ADHESIVES**

Stampin' Dimensionals  
Multipurpose Liquid Glue

Die cut "Happy Birthday" from the Pretty Peacock cardstock

Die cut the "Happy Birthday" outline layer from the Very Vanilla cardstock.

Using minimal amounts of liquid glue, adhere the Pretty Peacock Happy & Birthday to the Very Vanilla outline piece.

Set aside.

Adhere the DSP layer to the Lost Lagoon cardstock.

Adhere these layers to the card front.

Using dimensionals, adhere the Happy Birthday to the centre of the card front.

Die cut flower and hearts from the Fresh Freesia cardstock.

Using dimensionals (cut some in half if needed or use Mini Dimensionals) adhere the flower and hearts to the card front as desired.

Add Brass Butterflies as desired.

Decorate and adhere an insert piece to the inside of the card if desired and decorate the envelope.
