Pop Up Gate Fold

You will need:

Thoughtful Wishes bundle

Thoughtful Journey designer paper

Basic White cardstock

Early Espresso cardstock

Peach Pie cardstock

Peach Pie ribbon

Brushed Brass Butterflies

Unbounded Love dies

Early Espresso Ink

Measurements

Early Espresso 14.5 x 20cm scored at 5cm, 10cm, 15cm (5 ½ x 8 in) scored at 2, 4, 6 inches

Thoughtful Journey paper (4 pieces) 4.5 cm x 14cm (5 ¼ x 1 ¾ in)

Basic White 4.5 x 14cm (5 ¼ x 1 ¾ in)

Thoughtful Journey paper (4 pieces) 4.5 x 2cm (1 ¾ x ¾ in)

Early Espresso 7 x 10.5cm (3 x 4 in)

Thoughtful Journey paper 6.5 x 10cm (2 ¾ x 3 ¾ in)

Early Espresso 2 pieces 4 x 6 scored at 3 cm on long side for the hinges (1 x 3 in scored at 1 ½ in)

Early Espresso, Peach Pie and Basic White scraps for die cutting



How To

1. Fold the Early Espresso base card into a concertina
2. Fold both of the small hinge pieces of Early Espresso in half for the hinges
3. Adhere each of them either side of the centre fold of the base card with the fold of the hinge facing into the centre of the card
4. Adhere the Thoughtful Wishes paper over the tops of the hinges and on the front of the card.
5. Stamp leafy details onto the Basic White cardstock using Early Espresso ink
6. Add some extra pieces of designer paper on the top and bottom
7. Attach these panels to the inside of the card on each side of the centre
8. Adhere the feature panel of Early Espresso to the centre of the card using adhesive ONLY on the little hinge pieces
9. Attach some Thoughtful Wishes paper to the centre
10. Stamp a greeting onto the scrap of basic white and die cut using one of the frames from the Unbounded Love dies
11. Add some die cut embellishments under the greeting, along with a piece of ribbon and butterflies
