Stamps, Dies, Bundles, Punches or Suites

Decorative Trees

Cardstock/Papers Required

Pecan Pie 10.5 x 14.8 cm scored at 2.5, 5, 7.5, 10 cm (4 ¼ x 5 ½ in scored at 1, 2, 3,4 in)

Old Olive 12 pieces 4.5 x 5.5cm (1 ¾ x 2 ¼ in)

Season of Elegance 8 pieces 4 x 5 cm (1 ½ x 2 in)

Basic Beige 4 pieces 4 x 5 cm (1 ½ x 2 in)

Season of Elegance 12 pieces 4 x 2.5cm (1 ½ x 1 in)

Ink

Old Olive, Wild Wheat, Pecan Pie

Method

- 1. Create a Pecan Pie central 'trunk' box by adding tape to the small flap and adhering it to the other side creating the box shape.
- 2. Fold the box flat and then adhere one of the Old Olive pieces to the top of the panel on the right side up against the fold
- 3. Adhere another Old Olive piece to the middle of the flattened box on the opposite side of the fold
- 4. Repeat with a third Old Olive panel on the top
- 5. Flip the flattened card over and apply the next three panels in the same way to the fold on the left, testing along the way to be sure that the panels do not block each other.
- 6. Now you can add your designer papers and stamped Basic Beige panels to the larger blocks.
- 7. The 12 small pieces of the designer paper are for the reverse of each of the blocks so the card is completely decorated.
- 8. The trunk of the tree was stamped using Pecan Pie
