


# Masculine Barn Door Tutorial



## **Stamps, Dies, Bundles, Punches or Suites**

Beautiful Butterflies stamp set, Tags to Go Dies, Garden Meadow Dies

## **Cardstock/Papers Required**

Early Espresso 21 x 14.5 scored at 2.5 & 13 Card Base

Pecan Pie 10 x 14 and Basic White 9.5 x 13.5 Inside Card

Country Woods DSP 14 x 7.5, 14 x 2 Card Front

Early Espresso 10 x 2, 10 x 1.5 (x2) Cross Bars for door

Country Woods DSP 9.5 x 1.5, 9.5 x 1 (x2) Cross Bars for door

Espresso 1.5 x 7 and Basic White 1 x 6.5 for greeting

Old Olive 8 x 6 for foliage and Silver Foil scraps for die cutting

## **Ink**

Old Olive, Early Espresso

## **Extras**

Blending Brush, Enamel Effects copper

1. Fold the card base along the score lines to make the door
2. Adhere DSP to the card front
3. Adhere DSP to the cross bars
4. Anchor the main cross bar on the right hand side of the card for the main latch
5. Attach the other 2 cross bars at an angle leading to the main one, and trim the edges
6. Die cut the foliage from Old Olive cardstock using the Garden Meadow edge
7. Sponge with ink and add to the bottom of the door on the left side
8. Stamp the greeting using Early Espresso ink, layer and attach to the front of the card
9. Die cut the lock and keys using the Tags to Go Dies from the Silver Foil
10. Attach the bottom of the lock using mini dimensionals leaving the top free to slide the latch under it
11. Stamp another greeting for inside the card using Old Olive ink, layer onto the Pecan Pie and insert
12. Add more keys inside and copper enamel effects for the nails details
