## Stamps, Dies, Bundles, Punches or Suites

Label Me Grateful Bundle (online Exclusive); Mini Corrugated embossing folder

## **Cardstock/Papers Required**

Blackberry Bliss 14.5 x 21cm folded in half Basic White 10 x 14cm Granny Apple Green Two Tone 9.5 x 13.5cm White cardstock for colouring and die cutting Holographic Dots embellishments

## Ink

Berry Burst Ink; Stampin' Blends: Berry Burst, Blackberry Bliss, Granny Apple Green, Lemon Lime Twist **Method** 

- 1. Fold the card base in half
- 2. Emboss the Granny Apple Green Two Tone cardstock with the Mini Corrugated embossing folder
- 3. Sand the raised bumps to show the white core of the cardstock using a scrap of sandpaper
- **4.** Onto a large scrap of White Cardstock draw lines of colour ranging from light to dark using the Stampin' Blends stripes of Light Lemon Lime Twist, then Dark Lemon Lime Twist, Light Granny Apple Green and then Dark Granny Apple Green. Repeat with the Blackberry Bliss and Berry Burst Stampin' Blends.
- 5. Layer the dies on the coloured cardstock and die cut leaves from the greens and flowers from the pinks
- 6. Die cut the large label from White cardstock scrap
- 7. Using Berry Burst ink, stamp a greeting onto the top right corner of the die cut
- **8.** Adhere layers of White cardstock, sanded embossed Granny Apple Green cardstock, then the white label onto the front of the card
- **9.** Layer the die cut leaves and flowers next to the greeting on the label
- 10. Add Holographic Dots to the centres of the flowers and scattered around the label.
