Measurements

Paper	Number of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Gray Granite Cardstock	1	14.9cm x 21cm Scored at 10.5cm	5 ½" x 8 ½" Scored at 4 ¼"
Basic White Cardstock	1	20cm x 14.4cm Scored at 10cm	7 ¾" x 5 ¼" Scored at 3 7/8"
Basic Beige Cardstock	1	9.6cm x 14cm	3 ¾" x 5 1/8"
Nests of Winter DSP	1 1	4.8cm x 14.4cm 1cm x 14.4cm	1 7/8" x 5 3/8" ½" x 5 ¼"
Copper Clay Cardstock	1	7.5cm x 7.5cm	3" x 3"
Gold Mercury Vellum Specialty DSP	1	4.5cm x 4.5cm	1 ¼" x 1 ¼"
Basic White Cardstock for stamping	1	10cm x 14cm	4" x 5 ½"

Instructions

1. Cut all the cardstock layers needed that are listed in the measurement guide. Take the Gray Granite card base and cut at 5.2cm (2.1/8"). Retain the offcut and trim it to 4.8cm x

- $14.4cm (2" \times 5 3/8")$ then emboss with the Birch Wood 3D Embossing Folder with the pattern in a vertical direction.
- 2. Drag your Gray Granite ink pad lightly over the raised pattern from the embossing folder. Adhere to the front left panel of the card.
- 3. Take the Basic White scored cardstock and die cut 2 circles using the Deckled Circles Dies. Lay the card flat and open and place the 5th and 6th largest circles in the centre of one side of the cardstock and run through your die cutting machine. You will get 1 frame and 1 circle. Stamp the sentiment using Pebbled Path ink onto the Basic White circle.
- 4. Adhere the $4.8 \,\mathrm{cm} \times 14.4 \,\mathrm{cm}$ (1 7/8" x 5 3/8") DSP to the back of the front left panel of the card. Adhere the smaller strip of DSP to the right-hand edge of the card base.
- 5. Take the Basic White piece, now with a circle in the centre and emboss with the Birch Wood 3D Embossing Folder on the side with the circle with the pattern in a horizontal direction. Place the Basic Beige piece behind the circle. Glue around the edges of the Basic Beige piece and around the top of the circle but leave the bottom edge of the circle without glue.
- 6. Adhere the folded Basic White inner card onto the centre of the Gray Granite right-hand side of the card base.
- 7. Place the Copper Clay deckled circle over the circle in the Basic White inner card. Put adhesive on the left-hand side of the Copper Clay circle and adhere to the back of the front flap.
- 8. Adhere the Basic White circle you have stamped onto the front of the card, so the Copper Clay circle forms an even border around it.
- 9. Stamp the leaves, bird and buds (5) using Memento Black ink. Colour using Stampin' Blends Copper Clay, Old Olive, Wild Wheat, Smoky Slate, Gray Granite, Bronze & Ivory.
