














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## Measurements

Paper	Number of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Crumb Cake Cardstock	1	14.9cm x 21cm Scored at 10.5cm	5 ½" x 8 ½" Scored at 4 ¼"
Thoughtful Journey DSP*	1	10cm x 14.4cm	4" x 5 ¼"
Basic White Cardstock	1	6cm x 6cm	2 ½" x 2 ½"
Wild Wheat Cardstock	1	4cm x 8.5cm	1 ½" x 3 ½"
Mossy Meadow Cardstock	1	5cm x 7.5cm	2" x 3"
Three Colour Glimmer Paper (Highland Heather)	1	5cm x 7.5cm	2" x 3"
Petunia Pop Bordered Ribbon	1	27cm	10 ½"
Basic White Inner	1	10cm x 14cm	4" x 5 ½"

## Instructions

1. Create your card base and cut the DSP\* as mentioned in the video so that you're making the most of the pretty paper with this design. Adhere the DSP to the card base.



2. Die cut the leaves you are using from the Wild Wheat, Mossy Meadow cardstock and Glitter paper. Adhere to the front left side of the card following the video or Wild Wheat first, Mossy Meadow second and slightly lower than the first one and glitter paper on top.
3. Place some Tear and Tape strips on the card front for the ribbon. Start with an end on the left at the folded edge and lay the ribbon through the tape then back the other way and the other end is on the right.
4. Stamp the sentiment using Blackberry Bliss ink and while it's wet add Clear Embossing Powder. Heat to set using your heat gun. Die cut with the Stylish Shapes circle die. Adhere over the ribbon using glue dots.
5. Add some Blooming Pearls or Adhesive-Backed Pearl Trio or something else you have on hand.
6. To decorate the inner use the left-over piece of Thoughtful Journey DSP. I trimmed mine to 2.5cm and used liquid glue to adhere to the right side of the inner.
