



Nordic Inspired Christmas Card By Vanessa Baker –



Measurements

Paper	Number of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Basic White Thick Cardstock	1	14.9cm x 21cm	5 ½" x 8 ½"
		Scored at 10.5cm	Scored at 4 ¼"
Country Woods DSP	1	10cm x 15.2cm	4" x 6"
Basic White Cardstock	1	9.2cm x 13cm	3 5/8" x 5 1/8"
	1	8.5cm x 10cm	3 ¼" x 4"
	1	9.5cm x 7.5cm	3 ¾" x 3"
Basic Black Cardstock	1	3cm x 5.5cm	1 ¼" x 2 ¼"

Instructions

1. Use the 9.5cm \times 7.5cm (3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " \times 3") above of Basic White to stamp the 2 birds with the branches and berries using Early Espresso ink.

- 2. Colour the birds using Stampin' Blends Pecan Pie and Ivory. Colour the berries too. Die cut the birds using the corresponding die from the Winterly Tree Tops die set. Then add the Metallic Enamel Effects Basics Copper to the berries. Set aside to dry.
- 3. Create your card base and cut the DSP for the first layer. The size of the DSP is longer than the card as you're going to rip the left-hand side, so you have a torn edge. Then adhere the DSP to the card base.
- 4. Take the second measurement piece of Basic White and emboss with the Fern 3D Embossing Folder. Tear the 2 sides and retain the pieces torn off.
- 5. Die cut the leafy frame from the first measurement of Basic White Cardstock, so you have an even frame around the die before you run it through. Carefully remove the centre portion and keep to one side.
- 6. Adhere the fern embossed piece to the card front. Check the position with the frame first so you see a bit of white on the right-hand side of the frame.
- 7. Adhere the frame piece to the card front using small dots of glue on the sprigs and around the edge.
- 8. Add the birds to the card once the berries have dried using dimensionals.
- 9. Stamp the greeting using VersaMark ink on Basic Black cardstock, add white embossing powder and heat to set. Trim by hand into separate words. Adhere using black dimensionals if you have them.
- 10. Take the centre of the die cut frame from step 5 and lay onto the Basic White inner. Use a blending brush and Pecan Pie ink to lightly sponge between the sprigs and out to the edge. Add a torn piece of the same DSP from the front and a leftover piece from the white fern embossed piece to the inner, add the inner to the card.
