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Chocolate Wrapper with Nests of Winter DSP

Measurements

Paper	Number of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Nests of Winter DSP	Pattern 1	14cm x 21cm	5½" x 8½"
For Whittaker's Artisan Bar	Pattern 2	6cm x 21cm	2 ½" x 8 ½"
	Pattern 3	3.5cm x 21cm	1 ¼" x 8 ½"
Basic White Cardstock- Circle	1	9cm x 9cm	3 ½" x 3 ½"
- Stamping	1	5cm x 7.5cm	2" x 3 ½"
Garden Green Cardstock	1	5cm x 7.5cm	2" x 3"

Instructions

- 1. Measure your chocolate bar roughly around by adding each side together. Mine was 9cm front and back x approx. 1cm each side, so 9+9+1+1=20cm then add another 1cm for overlap at the back. (3 ½" + 3 ½" + 3/8" + 3/8" + ½"= 8 ¼" Use this formula for the size of any chocolate bar. Then work out the length of the bar and how much of each paper you want to see, this will determine the other measurement of each piece.
 My bar is 19cm (7 ½") long so I did 14cm, 6cm and 3.5cm = 23.5cm (5 ½" + 2 ½" + 1 ¼" = 9 ¼") This allows room for overlap for the adhesive. You could be more exact to use less length if you want to use less paper.
- 2. Once you have the width and length you need then you can cut the DSP. Make sure if your paper is directional that you cut it the right way. Take your time or you can waste a bit of paper.

- 3. If you are tearing the pieces, this is optional, do that so you are tearing with the side of the paper you want to see towards yourself to get the white centre of the paper to show on the right side.
- 4. Lay the pieces on the chocolate bar now to gauge the height before adhering each piece. Adhere all the layers to each other and then wrap the whole piece around the chocolate bar. Join at the back.
- 5. Die cut a circle from Basic White cardstock using the Spotlight of Nature dies. I chose a floral edged one. Stamp your sentiment onto the circle in Copper Clay ink and adhere to the front.
- 6. Stamp the spray of leaves and berries onto Basic White using Memento ink. Colour using Stampin' Blends Shaded Spruce Combo, Cherry Cobbler Combo, Pecan Pie, Gray Granite. Die cut the shape using the coordinating die.
- 7. Die cut some sprigs of greenery from the Garden Green cardstock, I used 4.
- 8. Fussy cut some pinecones and a sprig of greenery from the Nest of Winter DSP.
- 9. Arrange the leaves and pinecones at the top of the circle.
- 10. Place 3 Earth Tones Shimmer Gems.
