














## Measurements

Paper	Number of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Crumb Cake Cardstock	1	3.5cm x 18cm	1 ½" x 7 ½"
	1	2cm x 9cm scored at 1, 3.5, 4.5, 5.5 and 8cm	¾" x 4" scored at ½", 1 ½", 2", 2 ½" and 3 ½"
Basic White Cardstock	1	8.5cm x 21cm	3 ½" x 8 ¼"
	1	2cm x 8cm	¾" x 3"
Pecan Pie Cardstock	1	3cm x 4cm	1 ¼" x 1 ½"
Silver Foil	1	3cm x 6.5cm	1 ¼" x 2 5/8"
	1	2cm x 2cm	¾" x ¾"
Adhesive Sheet	1	3cm x 6.5cm	1 ¼" x 2 5/8"

## Instructions

1. Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide.
2. Stamp the small bow stamp randomly using Crumb Cake ink on the long Crumb Cake piece. Then score at 2.5, 6, 8.5, 11, 14.5 and 17cm (1", 2 ½", 3 ½", 4 ½", 6", 7")
3. Fold the score lines and burnish. Use liquid glue to adhere the small tab to the other end of the base, press together.
4. Take the smaller scored Crumb Cake piece and fold the scorelines as shown below
5. Glue the top 1cm scores in the middle together. Put liquid glue on the outside of the 1cm end tabs and insert into the centre of the stamped base. (see video approx. 10min mark) Set aside to dry.





6. Stamp the whole large solid tree stamp using Soft Sea Foam ink. Then stamp again with just the first 3 layers on the cardstock, then 2 layers and 1 layer. As per the image below. Follow afterwards with the detail stamp in Old Olive ink. Die cut each tree with the appropriate die.
7. Start with the 1- and 2-tiered images. Curl the bottom edge of the 1-tiered image upwards using a bone folder. Place a small dimensional underneath the curled edge and a spot of glue at the top point. Adhere over top of the 2-tiered image.
8. Curl the bottom edge of the 2-tiered image, place a dimensional underneath and glue up to the top point, adhere over the 3-tiered image. Repeat until all tiers have been glued and you have a completed tree.
9. Peel the backing from the adhesive sheet and adhere to the back of the silver foil. Use the tinsel die to die cut. Peel away the backing from each piece to reveal the adhesive and adhere the appropriate length to each layer of the tree.
10. Die cut the base from the Pecan Pie piece and adhere to the bottom of the tree. Then put glue on the top of the inner tab and attach the base to the tab so the tree sits above the crumb cake base. Fold flat and hold together for a few seconds.
11. Stamp the sentiment using Old Olive ink on Basic White cardstock. Die cut using the banner from Stylish Shapes Dies. Place the small dimensionals on the front of the crumb cake base and attach the sentiment.
