





Measurements

Instructions

- 1. Cut all the layers as per the cutting guide above. If your DSP is directional you want the pattern vertical.
- 2. Attach the DSP that will show at the top right first, this is your largest piece. Then add the smallest piece at the bottom, over the top. Line up the 3rd piece as per the sketch diagram, flip the paper over and draw pencil lines on the back of the last piece to see where to cut it. Cut along the pencil lines on your trimmer or with scissors. Adhere this over top of the other layers to the top left-hand side.
- 3. Die cut the circle from Basic White using the Stylish Shapes Dies. Place the circle over where the papers all meet, leaving a glimpse of the horizontal line on the right.
- 4. Die cut the rounded leaves from the Gold Mercury Vellum, the sprigs from the Graceful Greenery Vellum and the top spray of leaves from the Season of Green and Gold DSP. Adhere these pieces using dimensionals to the top of the circle.
- 5. Wrap the Gold Twisted Thread around 3 fingers to form loops. Pinch in the centre to form a bow shape. Adhere with a glue dot to the top spray of leaves.
- 6. Rub the thin Lost Lagoon piece of cardstock with the embossing buddy. Stamp Merry Christmas using VersaMark ink, cover with White Embossing Powder, tap off excess and heat to set. Adhere over the gold thread using dimensionals.
- 7. Take the thin piece of DSP and adhere to the bottom of the Basic White inner and adhere inside the card.
