Measurements

Paper	Number of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Basic Beige Cardstock – Base	1	10.5cm x 29.7cm scored at 14.85cm	4 ¼” x 11” scored at 5 ½”
- Layer	1	9.6cm x 14cm	3 ¾” x 5”
Fresh Freesia - Layer	1	10cm x 14.4cm	4” x 5 ¼”
Basic White Cardstock - Stamping	1	9.5cm x 13.9cm	3 5/8” x 4 7/8”
Lost Lagoon Cardstock – Sentiment	1	1.8cm x 8cm	¾” x 3 ¼”
Iridescent Trim	1	14.5cm	6”
	1	38cm	15”
Basic White Cardstock – Inner	1	10cm x 14.4cm	4” x 5 ¼”

Instructions

1. Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide. Cut and score the card base as stated, scoring and folding in half.
2. Emboss the Basic Beige layer using the embossing folder of your choice. I used Exposed Brick in the video and Forever Plaid for the first sample I showed.

3. Die cut a circle from Basic White using the largest die from Spotlight on Nature dies.
4. Stamp 2 of each of the herbs using the following colours: Rosemary – Smoky Slate, Thyme – Old Olive, Mint – Lost Lagoon and Basil – Pretty Peacock (only 1 needed). Then use the corresponding dies to cut them out.
5. Adhere each herb to the top of the large circle, coming to approx. the centre with the stems. Have the ones in the back higher so they are layered. I used liquid glue to approx. 2cm of the stem to adhere them. You want them to form a line across rather than follow the shape of the circle.
6. Adhere the circle to the embossed Basic Beige layer. Then wrap the shorter piece of ribbon over the front and evenly around on each side. Tape in place on the reverse.
7. Tuck the longer length of ribbon under and tie a bow so the ends are pointing off the card on the right.
8. After using the embossing buddy, stamp the sentiment in VersaMark ink, cover with White embossing powder, tap off the excess and heat to set. Trim the Lost Lagoon to a slanted right-hand end. Place dimensionals above the ribbon and attach to the card.
9. Adhere this layer to the Fresh Freesia layer, and then to the Basic Beige card base.
10. Add 3 Purple Fine Shimmer Gems.
11. Stamp the Mint on the inner using Lost Lagoon ink. Adhere inside the card.
