



Measurements

Basic White Thick Cardstock –	1	10.5cm x 29.7cm	4 ¼" x 11"

Basic White Cardstock	1	7.5cm x 10cm	3" x 4"
Basic Black Cardstock –			
Sentiment	1	1cm x 6.5cm	3/8" x 2 ½"
Iridescent Trim	1	38cm	15"
Fresh Freesia Cardstock – Inner	1	10cm x 14.4cm	4" x 5 ¼"

Instructions

- Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide.
 Cut and score the card base as stated, scoring and folding in half.
- 2. Emboss the Basic White Thick layer using the Beautiful Butterflies Hybrid Embossing Folder in a landscape direction.

- 3. Take the Floral piece of DSP and score down the longer side of the dsp at 1cm (3/8"). Position the butterfly die with the straight edge so the lines on the die go along the scoreline of the DSP. Use temporary tape to hold in position and run through the die cutting machine. Fold on the remaining parts of the scoreline and burnish.
- 4. Add liquid glue to the thin edge at the top of the butterfly die cut and centre onto the embossed layer. Fold the thin edge over to the back and press firmly.
- 5. Now add your secret message by embossing a word on the back of the butterfly. Make sure to stamp it so it can be read when the butterfly is flipped over while holding the card normally. I used the word hello and gold embossing powder.
- 6. With the other piece of DSP, the ombre side, stamp the large butterfly stamp with VersaMark ink, apply gold powder, tap of the excess and heat to set. Use the corresponding die to die cut the shape. Then place in the embossing folder against the large butterfly, carefully match the stamped image to the folder and carefully close. Run it through the die-cutting machine. The gold will now be raised.
- 7. Die cut the detailed butterfly from the set using the piece of Basic White cardstock. Cut in half through the body to separate the wings.
- 8. Place the white wings onto the large floral butterfly on each side. Place the gold embossed butterfly on top and position the pieces as you wish. Carefully take each of the white wings and apply liquid glue before sliding back into place.
- 9. Add dimensionals to the wings of the gold embossed butterfly and liquid glue on the body. Adhere over the white wings.
- 10. White emboss the sentiment onto Basic Black cardstock. Trim to size and separate the words. Adhere to the card using dimensionals so the butterfly can still flip over.
- 11. Colour the iridescent trim with a Dark Fresh Freesia Blend. Cut in half lengthways and use both pieces to create a bow shape and use the gold thread to tie the shape through the centre. Adhere to the butterflies using a glue dot and trim the ends of the ribbon.
- 12. Add 3 Purple Fine Shimmer Gems.
- 13. Stamp a butterfly on the inner using Fresh Freesia ink. Adhere inside the card on top of the Fresh Freesia layer.
