Measurements

Basic White Thick Cardstock – Base	1	10.5cm x 29.7cm scored at 14.85cm	4 ¼" x 11" scored at 5 ½"
Basic White Cardstock – Layer	1	10cm x 14.4cm	4" x 5 ¼"
- Scraps Piece - Butterfly	1 1	10cm x 12.5cm 7.5cm x 10cm	4" x 5" 3" x 4"
Designer Series Paper -Scraps	Depends on thickness	1cm – 1.5cm x 4cm -14cm	1⁄4" – 1⁄2" x 2"-5 1⁄2"
Basic White Cardstock - Butterfly	1	7.5cm x 10cm	3" x 4"
Melon Mambo Cardstock			
- Sentiment	1	2cm x 10cm	³ ⁄4" × 4"

Instructions

 Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide. Cut and score the card base as stated, scoring and folding in half.

- 2. Add liquid glue to the Basic White Scraps piece so you can glue approx. 4 strips of dsp down. I placed mine right next to each other, on an angle. You can experiment with different angles or using them straight. Once the 4 pieces have been stuck then add some more glue and stick a few more strips. Alternatively, you can add the glue to each strip but you're guessing how much you need as the strips will overhang the edge of the cardstock.
- 3. Once you have covered the cardstock flip it over and trim away the excess dsp by following the line of the cardstock. Position the butterfly die with the straight 1cm (3/8") gap at the top to the edge of the paper. Run through your die cutting machine. Trim away the excess paper from around the butterfly. Fold on the scoreline created by the die and burnish.
- 4. Add Fresh Freesia ink with a blending brush to the Basic White Layer. Flick some ink spatter using a Fresh Freesia Stampin' Write Marker or Blend. Stamp the sentiment over the top using Melon Mambo ink.
- 5. Add liquid glue to the thin edge at the top of the butterfly die cut and centre onto the stamped layer. Fold the thin edge over to the back and press firmly.
- 6. Die cut the detailed butterfly from the set using the piece of Basic White cardstock. Cut small strips of dimensional to raise the outer edges of the wings. Apply liquid glue to the body and adhere over top of the first butterfly.
- 7. White emboss the sentiment onto Melon Mambo cardstock. Die Cut using the larger label die in the set. Adhere to the card using dimensionals.
- 8. Add 3 Sequins.
- 9. Die cut a small, detailed butterfly from another piece of DSP and a body from Melon Mambo. Attach the body to the centre of the wings. Add Fresh Freesia ink with a blending brush to the bottom right corner of the Basic White inner. Adhere the butterfly over the blended area. Adhere the white inner to the Melon Mambo one and add to the inside of the card.
