## Measurements

Paper	Number of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Basic White Cardstock	1	30.5cm x 30.5cm	12" x 12"
Heirloom Arrangements Card	1	21.5cm x 14cm	8 ½" x 5 ½"
Bases to make layers	1	10.2cm x 14cm	4" x 5 ½"
Linen Thread	1	20cm	8"

## Instructions

1. Sponge Crumb Cake ink onto the square white page. I also added some Pretty In Pink but then I had to tone it down so just go very lightly with the pink. Then add some stamped off Crumb Cake stamps of the grid stamp.
2. Lay the opened card base over the page and decide on the angle that you want it to be on. Use the photo mat as well to make sure you have space for it.
3. Then I made 3 decorative clusters of elements from the kit. The tags at the top with the butterfly are all in soft brown shades. The tags are tucked under the card base layer and adhered with liquid glue. I added 2 glue dots on top of each other under each wing of the butterfly. I used liquid glue for the body.
4. The cluster on the left uses the black and white bordered element from the frame I used last week with shades of pink and green. I added a linen thread small bow to bring the cluster together. I used liquid glue for all except the flower head on the pink flower.

5. The final one is the oval floral label with the vellum version of the same flower in the background. I used glue dots for these pieces to give a little shadow underneath. The last pink flower found a home here and a brushed brass butterfly.
