# Supply List

All supplies can be purchased in my online store, this project is <u>Beautiful Gallery Partial Pop-Up Cards</u>. You can add all items to your cart and then remove what you don't need.

Partial Pop-up Framed Vintage Motif Card Inspired by Eve Monger Made by Vanessa Baker



## Measurements

Cloud Cover Cardstock	1	14.9cm x 21cm	5 ½" x 8 ½"

Secret Sea Cardstock	1	6.9cm x 11.2cm	211/16" x 4 3/8"
Beautiful Gallery 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper – 2 Frames (2 <sup>nd</sup> card uses large)	1	9.5cm x 13.7cm	3 ¾" x 5 ½"
Basic White Cardstock			
– Inside Frame	1	6.4cm x 10cm	2 ½" x 4"
- Flower	1	6cm x 11cm	2 ½" x 4 ¼"
- Inner	1	10cm x 14.4cm	4" x 5 ¼"

#### Instructions

- 1. Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide. Cut and score the card base as stated, scoring and folding in half.
- 2. Emboss the Cloud Cover Layer with the Damask embossing folder. Distress with the edge of paper snips creating rips and rough edges. Use your bone folder to rub one corner until the card will separate. You can also use Cloud Cover ink\* to sponge this and the edges to add to the vintage vibe. Adhere to the card base using liquid glue.
- 3. Stamp the flower using Secret Sea ink onto Basic White. Use Wink of Stella or a blender pen to drag some colour upwards on the petals and leaves. Once dry, die cut using the corresponding shape die.
- 4. On the Basic White inside frame piece stamp the floral motif stamp from Beautiful Motifs set in Basic Beige ink. Stamp the large round text stamp from Elements of Text in Basic Beige. NB: Experiment first, depending how inky your pad is you may wish to stamp off first on 1 or both.
- 5. Use the motif die to create the pop-up, run through your die cutting machine using the plates you would use for a normal cutting die. Sponge some Lost Lagoon or Cloud Cover\* ink over the pop-up to accentuate it. Use markers and blends in Cloud Cover, Crumb Cake and Lost Lagoon to splatter the background.
- 6. Adhere the vintage stamped piece to the frame by using liquid glue around the inside back of the frame. Then attach to the Secret Sea layer. Add to the card front with dimensionals.
- 7. Place the flower on the left-hand side using dimensionals and liquid glue.
- 8. Stamp the sentiment on a thin scrap of Secret Sea cardstock and emboss with Wow! white embossing powder, trim to size. Adhere over a Linen Thread bow using dimensionals.
- 9. Add three Pressed Flower Motifs.
- 10. On the inner stamp the small flower from Gallery Blooms using Secret Sea ink. Adhere into the card.

## Instructions

1. Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide. Cut and score the card base as stated, scoring and folding in half.

#### Vanessa Baker Independent Stampin' Up! Demonstrator

- 2. Adhere the large die cut frame from Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper to the card front
- 3. Stamp the flower using Secret Sea ink onto Basic White. Use Wink of Stella or a blender pen to drag some colour upwards on the petals and leaves. Once dry, die cut using the corresponding shape die.
- 4. Die cut the small frame from the Basic Beige piece and emboss using the Damask embossing folder.
- 5. Create the partial pop-up die cut on the Secret Sea piece. Position the Basic Beige frame over the Secret Sea piece and place the die so some of the leaves will be over top of the frame edge in the centre. Carefully remove the Basic Beige frame while holding the die in place. Run through your die cutting machine.
- 6. Do a dry fit before adding adhesive. You may need to snip some attachments so the frame will slide underneath the leaves. Then add adhesive just to the side of the frame with the leaves and manoeuvre into place before lifting the other 3 sides and adding adhesive. Add to the centre of the card using dimensionals.
- 7. Add the stamped flower using dimensionals.
- 8. Stamp the sentiment on a thin scrap of Secret Sea cardstock and emboss with Wow! white embossing powder, trim to size. See the video for how to mask off the other words on the Thank You stamp.
- 9. Adhere over a Linen Thread bow using dimensionals. Add three Pressed Flower Motifs.
- 10. On the inner die cut the corner motif from the Beautiful Motifs Dies. Sponge with Lost Lagoon or Cloud Cover\* ink. Add to the centre of the card.
