One Sheet Wonder Magic! 4 Stunning Cards with the Lovely Garden Suite

Measurements

| Paper | Number of Pieces | Metric Measurement | Imperial Measurement |
|-----------------------------|---------------------|--------------------|------------------------|
| Basic White Thick Cardstock | | 14.9cm x 21cm | 5 ½" x 8 ½" |
| - Card Bases | 4 | Scored at 10.5cm | Scored at 4 ¼" |
| Basic White Cardstock – OSW | 1 | A4 (21cm x 29.7cm) | US Letter (8 ½" x 11") |
| - Inner | 4 | 10cm x 14.4cm | 4" x 5 ¼" |
| Fresh Freesia Faux Velvet | | | |
| Ribbon | 2 | 22cm | 8 ¾" |

Instructions

- 1. Measure the centre on all 4 sides of the Basic White cardstock and connect each mark with a light pencil line. This is a guide to show how the card fronts will be cut later.
- 2. Stamp the line images from Thankful Garden stamp set using Memento black ink so they go across the lines and in from the edges. Be conscious of where you'll cut the cardstock later as you go. Use the image after step 5 to guide you.

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- 3. Use the Thankful Garden Masks to colour the images. The leaves on mask 4 are easy to line up and you can draw the little cut triangle lightly with pencil to help you line up the flowers later. Start with a light covering using Granny Apple Green and a blending brush. Then swap to mask 5 for the detail in the leaves. I used the same colour but applied more ink and more pressure for a contrast.
- 4. For the smaller set of leaves create your own mask but stamping the image on Basic White cardstock and cutting the centre of each leaf out with the knife attachment on your Take your Pick Tool. Now you can sponge Granny Apple Green through to colour this image.
- 5. Line up mask 2 for the flowers, I didn't use mask 1. I used Bubble Bath ink for a light layer of ink. Then with mask 3 I added Melon Mambo also with a light touch. You can go darker if you prefer a brighter contrast.



6. Rub out the pencil marks including the little triangles. Use your trimmer to cut the cardstock into quarters. Now you can decide how much more to trim and from which side to create a layer for card fronts. In metric I cut them to 10cm x 14.4cm, for US Letter you would do 4" x 5 ¼". At this stage it can go straight onto a Basic White Thick card base. Or you can trim another 4mm-5mm (1/4") off 2 sides and mount onto a coloured layer sized 10cm x 14.4cm or 4" x 5 ¼".

- Stamp the sentiment stamps using Memento black ink onto Basic White cardstock.
 Fussy cut or die cut the sentiments, I used the Textured Notes Dies for the rectangles.
- 8. Add ribbon underneath the sentiments, use dimensionals to adhere the sentiments.
- 9. Add three Starburst Sequins in Fresh Freesia. If you made your Melon Mambo quite dark, you may need to choose a different embellishment.
- 10. Stamp the small leaf on the inner, sponge through your mask with Granny Apple Green ink. Adhere to the inside of the card.
