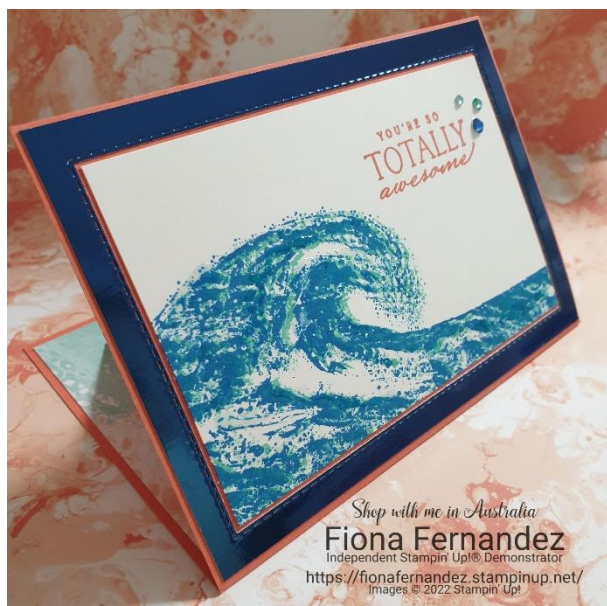


Upside Down Fancy Fold Card

Basic Supplies and Measurements

Supplies: I used the Waves of the Ocean Suite Collection for this card. [See Video showing card](#)

- Stamp Set of choice
- Designer Series Paper of choice
- Co-ordinating Coloured Cardstock – Calypso Coral
- Basic White Cardstock
- Embellishments of choice

- Inkpads I used, Calypso Coral, Pacific Point, Coastal Cabana.
- I used Shimmery Crystal Effects on the front wave
- Adhesives - Tombow Liquid Glue
- Card making tools:
Paper Trimmer, Take Your Pick, Stampin' Cut & emboss Machine
- Stitched Rectangle Dies

1. For your **card base** - cut coloured cardstock 14.85cm x 21cm. Score at 10.5cm on the long edge, so you end up with the folded card being 14.85cm x 10.5cm
2. **Front panel** for Stamp and Sentiment – cut Basic White A4 Cardstock 12.85cm x 8.35cm.
The wave I stamped twice, first with Pacific Point, then off to the right a little with Coastal Cabana.
Sentiment – I stamped with Calypso Coral.
3. **Message panel** on the inside – cut Basic White A4 Cardstock 14.8cm x 10.4cm. Score at 7.4cm on the long edge, so folded it is 10.4cm x 7.4cm. Stamp the Wave on the fold of the card, so it will be on the left bottom corner once it is folded. See photo.
4. **Designer Series Paper** – cut to 9.9cm x 14.3cm - to go on inside of card. Attach with thin line of Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. **Blue Foils** – Frame for Front of card. Cut piece 14.5cm x 10.2cm. Using the second largest Stitched Rectangle Die, cut a frame, extending it by 1cm lengthways. When die cutting, place the clear plate on top so it doesn't cover one end of the die. Then do another cut with the plate covering the die coming from the other end, and again leaving the first cut end exposed, and extending the length of the die cut.
