Instructions

1. Prepare the cardbase and cut all the layers.
2. Take the Pretty Peacock card base and stamp the card base with the small trio of hearts stamp in Pretty Peacock ink over the entire card base ensuring some of the images are stamped off the edge. Set aside.
3. Adhere the layer of Delightfully Eclectic Designer Series Paper to the larger layer of Pretty Peacock. Spritz ink from a Pretty Peacock Stampin' Write Marker over the top of this layer. Lay the layer of vellum slightly off centering it. Staple this piece in the centre where the focal point will cover the staples. Run a bone folder back and forth on the top right hand corner of this piece to break apart the cardstock fibres and break apart the fibres of the cardstock and fold back upon itself. Add a staple to hold in place. Adhere this layer to the card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Die cut two of the circles from the Deckled Circles dies using Smoky Slate Cardstock and the Delightfully Eclectic Designer Series Paper (die cut the larger one from Smoky Slate, and a smaller one from patterned paper) - it doesn't matter which size dies you use here - trial which size circles you want to use! Using a Blending Brush add some Smoky Slate ink around the Smoky Slate circle to add more definition. Adhere these circles together. Adhere to the card.
5. On some scrap Basic White Thick cardstock, stamp the milkshake components. I have stamped the milkshake glass in Smoky Slate and Basic Gray. I used a mixture of; Berry Burst, Melon Mambo, Sweet Sorbet, Fresh Freesia and Bubble Bath for my milkshake layers. For the straw I used Starry Sky and Tahitian Tide. I have cut these all out with the corresponding dies as well as cutting out three of the 'cream' layers from Basic White Thick. Cut six hearts from the hearts dies from Pretty Peacock Soft Shimmer Specialty Paper and set aside.
6. Using some Embossing Paste and a spatula, add some Embossing Paste to the 'cream' layers'. Using a Silicone Craft Sheet is really handy for doing this. Set aside to dry.



7. Start 'stacking' the milkshake layers. I have placed them altogether to decide on my placement and then used Press N' Seal to help keep them together to adhere, or you can lift them and use liquid glue to adhere each layer of milkshake together. Once the milkshake layers are adhered together, adhere the milkshake layers to the glass with Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the straw in the glass through the tiny 'slit' in the milkshake layer. Once the 'cream' is dry adhere where shown. Set aside.
8. Before adhering the milkshake to the card. Fray some of the Herringbone Ribbon and take about six strands, colour these with Melon Mambo Stampin' blends. Adhere to the card where shown. Adhere the milkshake over the top with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Stamp the sentiment in Berry Burst on Basic White cardstock and adhere to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Embellish the card with some of the sequins and then adhere some of the beautiful die cut hearts to the card with a mixture of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals. Add some Wink of Stella to the card. I also added some Wink of Stella over the top of my cream!
11. To decorate the inside of the card add some Berry Burst blending to the bottom right hand side of the card and then spritz some ink with a Berry Burst Stampin' Write Marker. Add the strip of Designer Series Paper to the bottom edge of the card and then the tiny strip of Soft Shimmer Paper above that. Add this to the layer of Pretty Peacock and embellish with the leftover Pretty Peacock die cut hearts.
12. Enjoy!
