Double Dutch Door Card





Key supplies used:

- <u>Tasteful Touches stamp set</u> (152562)
- ◆ Flower & Field Designer Series Paper (155223 SAB 2021)
- ◆ Small Bloom Punch (152316)
- ◆ Nature's Roots Dies (146341, note item code change from catalogue)
- Confetti Flowers Border Punch (152723)











You will need:

- ◆ Basic craft kit including scissors, adhesives and dimensionals
- ◆ A paper trimmer
- ◆ A means of scoring either with your trimmer or a score board
- Greeting stamps and black ink pad

Measurements

- Card base cut lengthways, 10.5cm x 29.7cm, scored at 14.8cm
- ◆ Door panel, 6cm x 21cm
- ◆ DSP design 1: 10cm x 8cm
- ◆ DSP design 2: two pieces 5.7cm x 4.8cm
- Basic Black cardstock, 6.5cm x 9cm
- ◆ Whisper White cardstock, 5.7cm x 8.2cm
- ◆ Whisper White cardstock, 10cm x 14.3cm

Instructions

- 1. Cut 6cm from the front of the card base and set this piece aside for later.
- 2. Take your door panel piece and score at 5.2cm from either end, to leave a 10.5cm panel in the centre. Fit this around the back of your card base; you may need to trim the card base slightly to enable it to fit snugly without puckering.
- 3. Ensure the front flap of the card also fits snugly; you may need to trim this very slightly so it doesn't overlap the front doors.
- 4. Take the larger piece of DSP and check its fit on the front flap. Trim if required then adhere.
- 5. Take the two smaller pieces of DSP and check their fit on the front doors. Trim if required then adhere.
- 6. Take the piece you cut off the card front and trim to 6cm x 8.5cm. Stamp your greeting onto the smaller white piece and layer this on top. Layer both pieces onto your Basic Black piece.
- 7. Arrange your die-cut leaves and stick to the top flap only, then pop up the greeting layer on top. Embellish with punched flowers and rhinestones.
- 8. Use any leftover DSP to create a decorative strip on the remaining large Whisper White panel and stick inside the card.
