# Desk calendar and sticky note holder






## Key supplies used:

- Flower & Field Designer Series Paper (155223 SAB 2021)
- ◆ <u>Bumblebee cardstock</u> (153082)
- Paper Trimmer (152392)







## You will need:

- ◆ Basic craft kit including scissors, adhesives and dimensionals
- ◆ A means of scoring either with your trimmer or a score board
- ◆ A calendar tab, sticky note pad and small pen or pencil

#### Measurements

- ◆ Card base cut lengthways, 10.5cm x 29.7cm, scored at 14.8cm
- ◆ Cardstock, 10cm x 10.5cm, scored as Fig A
- Cardstock cut to 11cm x 14cm, scored as Fig B
- ◆ DSP: 10cm x 14.3cm
- ◆ DSP: 8.5cm x 6cm

### Instructions

- 1. Take your card base and stick the larger piece of DSP to the front.
- 2. Take the 10x10.5cm cardstock and, if you haven't already done so, score as Fig.A.
- 3. Take the 11x14cm cardstock and, if you haven't already done so, score/cut as shown in Fig.B. (Solid lines are cuts.)
- 4. Take the 10x10.5cm piece and concertina fold, applying strong adhesive to the narrow flaps and sticking to the inside of the card base, as shown in the pic.
- 5. Stick the smaller DSP piece to one of the large panels on the 11x14cm cardstock piece. Fold and stick to make a slim box. Stick this to the front of your card base.
- 6. Finally, stick on your calendar tab then add the sticky note and pen.
