

Desk calendar and sticky note holder



Key supplies used:

- ✦ [Flower & Field Designer Series Paper \(155223 - SAB 2021\)](#)
- ✦ [Bumblebee cardstock \(153082\)](#)
- ✦ [Paper Trimmer \(152392\)](#)



You will need:

- ✦ Basic craft kit including scissors, adhesives and dimensionals
- ✦ A means of scoring - either with your trimmer or a score board
- ✦ A calendar tab, sticky note pad and small pen or pencil

Measurements

- ◆ Card base cut lengthways, 10.5cm x 29.7cm, scored at 14.8cm
- ◆ Cardstock, 10cm x 10.5cm, scored as Fig A
- ◆ Cardstock cut to 11cm x 14cm, scored as Fig B
- ◆ DSP: 10cm x 14.3cm
- ◆ DSP: 8.5cm x 6cm

Instructions

1. Take your card base and stick the larger piece of DSP to the front.
2. Take the 10x10.5cm cardstock and, if you haven't already done so, score as Fig.A.
3. Take the 11x14cm cardstock and, if you haven't already done so, score/cut as shown in Fig.B. (Solid lines are cuts.)
4. Take the 10x10.5cm piece and concertina fold, applying strong adhesive to the narrow flaps and sticking to the inside of the card base, as shown in the pic.
5. Stick the smaller DSP piece to one of the large panels on the 11x14cm cardstock piece. Fold and stick to make a slim box. Stick this to the front of your card base.
6. Finally, stick on your calendar tab then add the sticky note and pen.
