

# Crafty Friday - July 2021

## Kit list

- Basic craft kit including scissors, adhesives, dimensionals and double-sided tape
- A paper trimmer plus a means of scoring
- Greeting stamps
- Ink pad in Pear Pizzazz, Old Olive, Calypso Coral, grey or black

## Simple double Z-fold card

**This is a LOT easier than it looks. Trust me.**

## Measurements

- Pale Papaya card base, cut lengthways and scored at 14.8cm
- Calypso Coral: 21cm x 7cm
- White: two pieces, 6.5cm square
- Designer Series Paper for inside: 14.3cm x 10cm
- Designer Series Paper for front panel: 7cm x 10cm

## Instructions

1. On the front of your Pale Papaya card base, score at the halfway point; 7.4cm and fold this back on itself. This is Panel A.
2. Stick the larger DSP piece to the inside of the card (Panel C) and the smaller to the front, folded-back panel (Panel A). When you open it out, it looks like this...



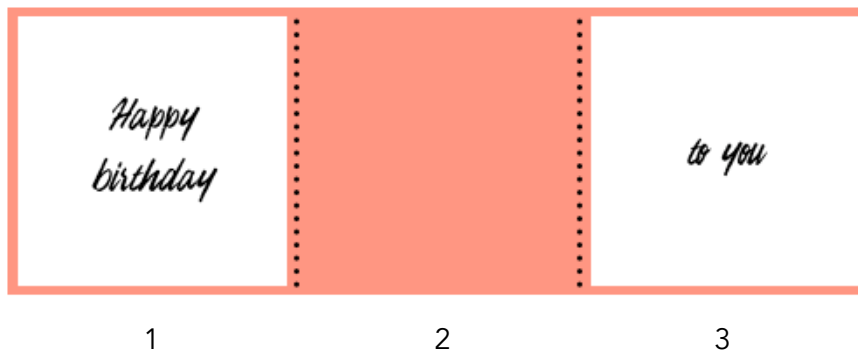

3. Your Calypso Coral piece should be scored at 7cm and 14cm and folded into a Z shape.
4. It follows the same pattern as the outer piece but on a smaller scale and is folded in exactly the same way.



5. Stamp greetings onto the two white squares and attach these to Panel 1 and Panel 3 as shown here.
6. With the Calypso Coral piece folded into the closed position, stick the back of Panel 3 to Panel C (the inside of the card), in the centre of the DSP.
7. Close the front of the outer body of the card with Panel A folded back. Lift Panel 1 over the top. Apply glue to **half** of the back of Panel 1 - you only need glue where it comes into contact with Panel A.
8. Decorate the front white square panel with as many peaches/flowers as you like. For the inside, ensure any decoration doesn't overlap the Calypso Coral square, so it cannot be seen when the card is closed.
9. Tie a piece of ribbon around Panel A, finishing with a bow. Finish off with some Genial Gems on the front panel.

## Peaches/flower card

This simple but versatile card design would work with any Designer Series Paper and images. It's literally just a panel on the front with some decoration – but swapping papers and images makes all the difference.

### Measurements

- Standard card base in Calypso Coral (14.8cm x 21cm, scored at 10.5cm).
- Pear Pizzazz 6.5cm x 9.5cm
- DSP: 10cm x 14.3cm

### Instructions

1. Attach the DSP to the card front.
2. Stamp a greeting at the bottom of the die-cut panel and attach to the Pear Pizzazz panel.
3. Choose some flowers or peaches to cut out for your decoration and pop these up using Dimensionals onto the white panel.
4. Hold a double piece of Linen Thread around the front of the white panel and attach at the back using tape. Take a second piece and tie around it in a bow. Attach to the card front using Dimensionals.
5. Attach your cut-out shapes onto the white panel using Dimensionals.
6. Finish off with some Genial Gems.



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
