

Card with optional gift card holder

Kit list

- Basic craft kit including adhesives and Stampin' Dimensionals
- Christmas Season stamp set if you have it - or other sprigs, foliage, pine cones
- Christmas greeting stamps
- A paper trimmer plus a means of scoring
- Ink pads in green, red, brown

Measurements

- ◆ Garden Green: 12cm x 18cm, scored at 12cm
- ◆ Garden Green: 9cm x 18cm, scored at 9cm
- ◆ White: 8.5cm square (two of these)
- ◆ DSP: 11.5cm square
- ◆ DSP: 11.5cm x 5.5cm
- ◆ DSP: 11.5cm x 3cm

1. The large folded green card opens backwards. With the large square on the left and the card open, stick the square of DSP on the inside.
2. Close the card
3. Keeping the card open, stick the 11.5cm x 3cm piece on the right panel.
4. If you wish to make this into a gift card, on the inside of this same panel, stick the DSP at the top and bottom only so a card will slide in. There is only just enough space.
5. Make the small card to go on the front. Stamp one white square to decorate the front.

TIP: When adding extra elements such as the pine cone shown here, make sure it doesn't stick out too far on the left or the card won't open.

6. Stamp a greeting on the second square of white, leaving space to write in the card.
7. Stick this to the inside of your main card, with an equal border around all four sides.
8. Finally tie a ribbon around the front flap and finish off with embellishments, if desired.
