




FLOWERPOT POCKET CARD

- Cinnamon Cider, 15cm x 9.5cm
- TWO pieces Cinnamon Cider, 2.5cm x 9.5cm
- Very Vanilla, 11cm x 5.5cm
- Very Vanilla for stamping on
- Crumb Cake label
- Very Vanilla Scalloped Lace Trim
- Linen thread
- 1. Score the largest piece of Cinnamon Cider at 7.5cm to make your card base.
- 2. With the fold at the top, mark 2cm from each side, along the bottom (open) edge.



- 3. Cut a diagonal line from the top corner down to the 2cm marks as shown in the diagram.
- 4. Measure 2cm from each end along the fold and cut a 5.5cm (or slightly larger) slot along the crease.
- 5. Sponge/brush ink around the edges of all three pieces of Cinnamon Cider.
- 6. Attach Lace Trim to the bottom edge of both small Cinnamon Cider strips.
- 7. Assemble the flowerpot, using the two strip on the front and back next to the fold.
- 8. Stamp, colour and cut out your image.
- 9. Stamp a greeting onto the Very Vanilla cardstock and insert it into the slot so none of it shows at the bottom of the flowerpot.
- 10. Lay this on top of the envelope to use as a guide then arrange your flowers, ensuring they will fit inside. You may wish to pop some up so it slides in and out easily.
- 11. Finish by stamping the label, tying linen thread around and attaching to the card front.
