

WOODEN HEART ORNAMENT

HEART ORNAMENT

- Wooden heart
- Aspen Tree die cut in Basic White
- Two Grove Dies mounds in Basic White
- Two deer in Distressed Gold
- Leaves (Forever Flourishing) in Gold and Basic White
- White Glittered Organdy Ribbon
- Thread or trim for hanging

1. Begin by firmly sticking the Aspen trees to the wooden heart. Trim with scissors.
2. Using a Crumb Cake or Sahara Sand ink pad and water painter or paintbrush, lightly colour one side of the tree trunks to create a shadow.
3. Attach the deer in the centre of the heart, about 2.5cm / 1" from the bottom point.
4. Attach one of the mounds on top, just covering the deer's feet. Don't worry; the mound won't reach the bottom point – this is where the second mound comes in.
5. Using glue, attach the second mount at the bottom point of the heart, leaving the top edge loose. Attach the second deer, poking its feet just behind the second mound.
6. Thread the trim through the hole and tie in a knot, keeping it at the back or, if it's small enough poking it into the hole itself.
7. Sponge around the edges of the white leaves then stick down at the top, covering the hole. Attach the gold leaves on top.
8. Tie a bow using white ribbon and attach this on top using a Glue Dot.
9. Finish with rhinestones.

NB: The Iridescent Trim used on the heart on the right has sold out in Europe since I made this project. I suggest using the gold from Simply Elegant Trim instead, as illustrated on the left heart.
