
Meerkat Treat Holder



- Coastal Cabana: 11.5cm x 9.5cm. Score at 2.5cm all round. Add tape where shown.
- Grapefruit Grove: 12.5cm x 7.5cm, scored at 5cm from each end.
- Belly band (Coastal Cabana): 14.5cm x 3.8cm
- DSP for the front: 4.5cm x 7cm
- Contrasting DSP belly band: 14.cm x 2.5cm
- DSP for Love Hearts: 7cm x 3cm (three pieces)
- Whisper White scraps
- Ribbon
- 1. To make the tray, take the Coastal Cabana piece, scored all the way round at 2.5cm (dotted lines) and cut where the lines are solid. Assemble into a tray, with the tape on the underside.



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2. Take your Grapefruit Grove piece to make the jacket. This is scored at 5cm from either end, as shown here. Fold to make a "book jacket" and attach your largest piece of DSP to the front.

- 3. Now you can attach the Coastal Cabana tray to the inside of the jacket, butting it up to the spine as closely as you can.
- 4. Take your three strips of DSP and wrap them around the Love Hearts. Don't hold back on the tape!
- 5. To make the belly band, take the strip of Coastal Cabana cardstock and score at 6cm from each end. Don't score the DSP.
- 6. Take this strip and the matching DSP and punch both pieces at both ends using the Delightful Tag Topper Punch. *If you are not using a punch, you can reduce the length of these strips by 0.5cm.*
- 7. Attach the DSP strip to the Coastal Cabana strip and gently fold it around the treat holder. Adding the treats first will give it more stability.
- 8. Tie the two ends together using ribbon and then decorate as desired.

This project was inspired by <u>Mary Fish's Nugget Holder</u> which, in turn was inspired by <u>Kadie</u> <u>Labadie's Tic Tac holder</u>. Can we keep this going? Maybe you're inspired to make your own holder to fit your favourite treats?
