- Bouquet of Love Hybrid Embossing Folder
- Sweet Talk 12"x12" Designer Series Paper
- Sweet as a Peach Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Basic White 8½"x11" thick cardstock
- Basic White 8½"x11" cardstock
- Real Red 8½"x11" cardstock
- Crumb Cake 8½"x11" cardstock
- Real Red Classic Stampin' Pad
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine
- Stampin' Seal
- Stampin' Dimensionals

Cutting Guide

Basic White Thick cardstock 5½" x 8½", scored along long

side at 41/4"

Basic White cardstock 3½" x 3"

Real Red cardstock Two ½" x 3" strips

Crumb Cake cardstock 2" scrap

Sweet Talk DSP 3" x 5½" (pattern should make

sense when paper is portrait)

Instructions

- 1. Fold Basic White Thick cardstock to form the card base.
- 2. Stick Sweet Talk Designer Series Paper panel to the center of the card front using Stampin' Seal. The pattern should run from top to bottom.
- 3. Die cut a heart using the die from the Bouquet of Love dies from the center of the Basic White 3½" x 3" panel.
- 4. Adhere strips of Real Read cardstock to the left and right back sides of the heart panel, allowing approx. %" of the Real Red to be visible from the front of the panel.
- 5. Stick the heart panel towards the to of the front of the card, overlapping the DSP panel so the heart aperture shows the DSP pattern, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6. Stamp the "To a sweet friend!" sentiment from the Sweet as a Peach stamp set onto your scrap of Crumb Cake cardstock
- 7. Die cut the sentiment from your Crumb Cake scrap using the smallest label die from the Bouquet of Love dies.
- 8. Adhere your sentiment to the bottom right corner of the Basic White panel on the front of the card using Stampin' Seal. Overlap the left edge of the label die cut with the edge of the heart so that it partially floats over the DSP visible through the heart.
